

HISTORIC BARNS OF OHIO AT THE LOGAN COUNTY TRANSPORTATION MUSEUM

APRIL 13TH, 2023

Author and painter Robert Kroeger will be doing a painting demo, using palette knives and impasto technique, of an old barn. The painting will be available via a raffle, as a fundraiser. After finishing the demo, he will be telling stories about some of the barns he has painted. There will be a book signing after his program. Kroeger's first book, HISTORIC BARNS OF OHIO, lists the paintings and essays of barns

in all 88 Ohio counties (released by The History Press, March, 2021). His second book on old barns, ROUND BARNS OF AMERICA, will also be available. This book features 75 round barns in 32 states - from the east coast to the west coast - along with their paintings and stories. There are 11 Ohio round barns in the book (published by Acclaim Press in late 2022).

The event is open to the public.

CURATOR'S CORNER

The Logan County History Center enjoyed a great year in 2022 as we returned to more normal operations after feeling the effects of the pandemic in 2020 & 2021. After a two-year absence we once again welcomed local third graders on field trips to the History Center, as well as reinstating the Logan County Landmark Third Grade field trip grant program in which we take students to various historic sites in the county. These field trips, along with the programs we take

into the schools, help us fulfill one of our primary goals of working with the schools to help promote Logan County's rich history.

The History Center has returned to our full complement of programs. In December of 2021, we held our ever-popular Christmas at the History Center open house with dozens of local organizations, businesses, and individuals decorating trees throughout the Museum and the Orr Mansion, as well as lending their musical talents during the two weekends. The Fun, Funky, & Fascinating Finds of the History Center open house lived up to its name by featuring some of the more intriguing artifacts in the Museum's collection and allowed us to highlight some of the more interesting stories and people in Logan County history. Our annual Halloween KidFest saw nearly 200 children trick-or-treat through the History Center. This is always one our favorite events. The Young Historians started up again after being unable to meet for 1½ years. We also resumed our Society meetings and partnered with the Logan County Land Trust, Piatt Castle Mac-A-Cheek, and the Indian Lake Area Historical Society on programs.

The History Center continued our emphasis on increasing our social media presence. Our Facebook followers keep growing and growing with some of our biweekly posts reaching over 40,000 readers! We thank you for your "likes," "shares" and comments. Social media continues to be one our more important means of sharing Logan County's remarkable history, and a great way to use our wonderful collection of photographs and historical resources in the LCHS Archives.

The multi-year restoration project on the Orr Mansion's exterior continues to be a key focus. Over the last few years, we have repaired the $3^{\rm RD}$ floor dormers, replaced the columns and capitals on the front porch and portico, and re-stained and re-sealed the $1^{\rm ST}$ floor porch ceiling. More work on the mansion will continue in 2023 (and beyond) with plans to get the $2^{\rm ND}$ and $3^{\rm RD}$ floor balconies fully refurbished. Unfortunately, this type of restoration work is specialized and beyond the regular maintenance of the historic home.

Once again, we are asking you for your support and help. Included in this newsletter is a membership/donor card; we hope you will consider one or more of the options available. We appreciate your contribution of money or time, but more importantly, we encourage you to visit the Logan County History Center. We know you will be pleased!
